The Reserves were in good shape; the HSBC account had been designated the Employee Reserves account to contain funds to safeguard employees wages, as required by the Charity Commission. Mr Paul Kennerley proposed acceptance of the report, seconded by Miss Jacky Foot. The Rector thanked the Treasurer for her hard work. The City Deanery Synod Report was proposed by Mr Stephen Priddle, seconded by Mr Stephen Plumb, The Fabric Report was proposed by Dr Thomas Miskell, seconded by Mr Peter Chadwick, The Goods & Ornaments Report was proposed by Mr Cliff Radmore, seconded by Mr Tom Buchanan and The Electoral Role Report (up from 126 to 134 despite 57 members having left) was proposed by Mr Kim White, seconded by Dr Thomas Miskell. All Reports were accepted nem con.
Rector	The Rector said that he and the Standing Committee were investigating where God was leading us, where we can continue to achieve growth.
